1994	Application for a special operating plan to cover the northern part of the Friedrichshall potash tailings pile
1995	Construction of a construction waste recycling plant (RC plant), between the Mittelland Canal and the southern foot of the tailings pile
1996	Approval of a special operating plan to cover the northern side of the Friedrichshall tailings pile with soil and construction waste
2009	Application for approval of an outline operating plan for covering the Friedrichshall tailings pile construction waste
2010	Approval of the general operating plan for the complete covering of the tailings pile with soil and construction waste
2022	The Friedrichshall tailings pile is completely covered
