

Acceptance and Delivery Terms

Untereizbach Underground Waste Recovery Plant (UTV UB) (Last revised: September 2026)



Exclusion criteria

Waste with one or more of the properties listed here cannot be accepted:

- Radioactive waste.
- Waste that reacts with salt rock.
- Waste contaminated with agents of communicable diseases.
- Waste that is toxic upon contact and/or inhalation.
- Penetrating or unpleasant smelling waste¹.
- Explosive waste, waste capable of forming an explosive atmosphere or oxidising waste.
- Self-igniting and spontaneously combustible waste.
- Dust-explosive waste.
- Waste that forms toxic and/or explosive gas mixtures².
- Waste exceeding permissible dust concentrations outside the closed system.
- Waste with a free lime content exceeding the usual substance-specific level determined by analysis (declaration analysis).
- Waste with a residual moisture content on delivery of more than approx. 1 wt.% (special arrangements are possible in individual cases).
- Waste, with a grain size > 1.0 mm.

Information on the verification/notification procedure

- **The Untereizbach Underground Waste Recovery Plant (UTV UB) may accept waste from Germany in a privileged procedure in accordance with the Ordinance on Waste Recovery and Disposal Records.**
- Notification is required for waste not originating in Germany.
- Please contact us regarding the documents to be submitted.
- The UTV UB's declaration of acceptance is based on the waste declaration submitted by the waste producer and on the analytical results obtained from a representative sample of the waste. The approval of the waste regarding its harmlessness in terms of mining and industrial hygiene as well as its suitability for soil mechanics is based on expert opinions by recognised expert bodies.

If significant changes occur in the type, quantity or origin of the waste, compared with the information provided in the declaration, the UTV UB must be informed immediately in writing.

Required accompanying documents

- The required accompanying documents depend on the type and origin of the waste as well as on legal requirements. **They must be completed in full and presented at the time of acceptance. Otherwise, we are entitled to reject the delivery.**
- For deliveries from Germany: accompanying certificates³, written instructions, and weighing card as well as the ADR certificate for dangerous goods.
- For deliveries from abroad, the consignment note and dispatch/accompanying form are also included.
- **In addition to the legal requirements, the accompanying documents must indicate the K+S code.**
- If the weighing card is missing, the waste will be weighed during the acceptance. The costs will be invoiced.

Deliveries will only be accepted once a written confirmation of the appointment has been received.

Lorry delivery:

- If delivered by silo lorry, the tank operating pressure must be designed for max. 2 bar.
- Lorries and containers must be technically in good working order. (Note: Unloading air is provided by UTV. The pressure relief valve must be adjusted to the max. operating pressure and must be functional).
- The maximum waste temperature for deliveries by silo lorry (core temperature) is 80°C.
- When prepared as a suspension, the waste must be hydraulically transportable.
- Required inspections: for dangerous goods containers in accordance with GGVSEB (ordinance on the national and international carriage of dangerous goods by road, rail and inland waterways); for non-dangerous goods containers in accordance with the Pressure Equipment Directive. The inspection dates and max. operating pressure must be legible on the type plate.

³ In accordance with the Ordinance on Waste Recovery and Disposal Records, mandatory documents for hazardous waste must be kept electronically.

- The waste must be mechanically and pneumatically conveyable in a dry state upon delivery and free from clumps, lumps, sharp-edged materials, foreign objects, especially metal parts or similar.
- Silos must be equipped for unloading with Storz A- couplings (outlet at the rear).
- Silos must not have sight glasses in the conveying equipment.
- In case of strong winds, the unloading must be stopped and UTV staff must be informed.

The lorry drivers must have a basic knowledge of the German language and must be able to operate their silo lorries safely. Safety instructions are provided on site; they are valid for 1 year and must be renewed upon expiry. The safety instructions must be followed. Personal protective equipment such as safety shoes, helmet, safety goggles and high-visibility vest, must be carried on the vehicle and worn when entering the site. Mask and gloves must also be carried and worn if necessary. If the safety regulations are not complied with, unloading may be prohibited or stopped.

Acceptance of waste at the Unterbreizbach UTV

- Each waste delivery is subject to an acceptance control, which verifies the identity of the waste. Processing takes about 45 minutes. The duration of the unloading process depends on the waste properties. The UTV assumes no liability for compliance with specified timeframes.
- Waste that does not comply with the declaration in the disposal certificate or the notification, including the information contained in the supplementary sheets, can be rejected. Costs incurred due to defective deliveries will be charged.
