

**Type of Waste**

For shipping hazardous waste, you will need the waste's UN-number.

- You can find the UN-number of common waste types in the file "[Hazard Classification](#)".
- Comprehensive information on all waste types is included in the ADR-regulations.

**Consignment Note**

For each waste type, you need to complete a separate "[Consignment Note](#)", so that laboratory staff will know what they will be handling.



**Packaging**



Prior to shipping, all samples need to be packed in appropriate containers:



- In the "[Hazard Classification](#)"-file you will also find detailed instructions on the maximum volume of waste you may send per sample, respectively per packing unit. To find out, simply refer to the UN-No.

**Labelling**

Exterior packaging needs to be provided with a stick-on warning diamond:
