Know-how is also important for meeting new challenges. K+S shares its expertise with farmers, advisors, distributors, and young professionals through personal interactions and the KALI Academy. The KALI Academy is K+S's knowledge platform for plant nutrition and offers webinars, podcasts, videos, and valuable practical tips. Now, the knowledge of the KALI Academy is also available in **interactive online courses**. These courses offer further training

for beginners and professionals. The courses are structured in a didactic manner, alternating between short videos, brief reading passages, and engaging exercises. This ensures that the knowledge sticks.

"There is a strong interest in general information on plant nutrition because there are important measures that can be taken to ensure reliable yields," says Elisabeth Morgen, International Coordinator at the KALI Academy. "With the KALI Academy's online courses, we have presented relevant knowledge in a way that makes learning new things or refreshing existing knowledge fun."

The academy currently offers three free online courses: "Fundamentals of Plant Nutrition," "Magnesium – The Underrated Nutrient," and "Boron – For Roots and Flowers." These courses provide relevant, expert knowledge on two important nutrients. Additional courses will be offered in the future.

In addition, K+S has completely overhauled its app, the **KALI-TOOLBOX**. The app's most popular feature is the photo gallery of deficiency symptoms, which helps farmers identify and remedy nutrient deficiencies. The new app illustrates typical deficiency symptoms in 3D models, making them easier to recognize. Users can also calculate the optimal quantity of fertilizer for soil and foliar fertilization and convert information into various nutrient forms, such as SO₃ and S.
